DigiSep - 5

Each enteric coated tablet contains: Serratiopeptidase 5 mg

DigiSep - 10

Each enteric coated tablet contains: Serratiopeptidase 10 mg

Pack Size: 30 tablets x 5 blisters.

DRUG CATEGORY: ENZYME; Anti – inflammatory

DESCRIPTION:

Serratiopeptidase is an enzyme derived from bacteria of genus Serratia and found in Japanese silkworm.

MECHANISM OF ACTION:

DigiSep activates Plasmin from Plasminogen; Plasmin then breaks the fibrin barrier. Breaking of fibrin improves and restores circulation, resolves edema and hematoma. Serrase help in thickened blood, increased risk of stroke and heart attack. It accelerates liquefaction of pus and sputum and enhances the action of antibiotics. It shows mucolytic activity in sinuses, ear cavities that help in faster cure rates.

INDICATIONS:

- Post-operative inflammation and traumatic swelling
- Rheumatoid and osteoarthritis.
- In cardiovascular conditions
- Asthma, bronchitis and sinusitis
- Infections
- Carpal tunnel syndrome
- Dental infections like Pericoronitis.
- Dermatoses
- Fibrocystic breast diseases such as breast engorgement
- Sprains and torn ligaments

DOSAGE: 5 to 10mg thrice a day after meal, to be swallowed whole without chewing.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: DigiSep is contraindicated in patients having blood coagulation abnormalities and those with severe renal and hepatic disturbances.

ADVERSE EFFECTS: Gastro intestinal disturbances like anorexia, gastric discomfort and nausea may occur. Hypersensitivity reactions like skin rashes have been encountered.
